Site Location & Description

The development is located at Cloghabrody, Thomastown and is accessed from the R448 (Old N9) via Berkeley Lawns Phase 1 (Phase 1 was taken in charge in May 2008). Kilkenny County Council granted permission for 44 dwellings under P03/1559 on 5th April 2004. This was subsequently appealed to An Bord Pleanála by a 3rd party and the Board granted permission with revised conditions on 15th November 2004. The 44 dwellings are a mixture of detached and semi-detached and consist of two-storey buildings along with dormer bungalows.


Recommendation:
