Re: Community and Cultural Facilities Capital Grant Scheme 2019

A Chara,

The Community and Cultural Facilities Capital Scheme (CCFCS) 2018-2020 was adopted by Kilkenny County Council at its meeting held in January 2018. The previous scheme (2015-2017) had been reviewed with elected members from each Municipal District and with the members of SPC 3 prior to the adoption by Council of the current scheme. Members also agreed with the internal evaluation process being undertaken prior to the submission to the full Council of the recommendations of the Director of Services.

The Scheme is funded from development contributions and an annual budget of €250,000 is provided. The budget for 2019, therefore, is €250,000.

Applications for the 2019 CCFCS were advertised with a closing date for receipt of applications of Friday 3^{th} May 2019. The Council received a total of 16 applications and the overall amount being sought is $\leqslant 526,360$.

The applications were evaluated in a two stage evaluation process having regard to the following:

- The feasibility and realistic nature of the project and the matching funds being in place,
- The extent to which the capital project supports the objectives of the County Development Plan,
- The community collaboration and consultation involved and the extent to which the project supports broader community uses,
- The need for the project and the added value that the project will bring,

- The capacity of the community group to deliver the project,
- The demonstration of social inclusion and accessibility and
- The level of disadvantage and social circumstances in the area.

The number of applications received and the variety and nature of the projects illustrate significant local community commitment to community, rural and cultural development.

In the context of the available budget of €250,000 and having regard to the criteria of the Scheme and the evaluation undertaken, I recommend the following applications be grant aided under the Community and Culture Facilities Grant Scheme 2019.
