TO: An Cathaoirleach and Each Member of Kilkenny County Council.

Kilkenny County Council advertised the 2019 Arts Act Grants in December 2018; the closing date for receipt of applications was the 21st of January 2019.

Under the Arts Act 2003 Local Authorities may provide financial assistance for the purposes of:

- Stimulating interest in the Arts
- Promoting knowledge and/or appreciation of the Arts
- Enhancing standards in the Arts

The expression "the Arts" means creative or interpretive expressions (traditional or contemporary) in whatever form and includes in particular visual arts, theatre, literature, music, film, dance and multi-disciplinary events.

The following represent the categories of applicants to which grant allocations may be awarded:

- Groups and Organisations promoting the Arts
- Individual artists- all art forms- to enable them to pursue their practice, to develop within their chosen discipline and deliver projects.

A total of 27 applications were received to a total value of €36,724.47. To assist with the assessment of the applications an assessment panel was convened on the 5th February 2019 to assess the grant applications. The assessment panel included:

- Mary Butler, Arts Officer

Having reviewed the applications and the panel's assessment, I recommend that a total of 18 grant awards be made, as set out on the table attached.
