

*Minutes of Municipal District of Piltown Special Meeting held Wednesday,  
21<sup>st</sup> June, 2017 at 3pm at Meeting Room, Ferrybank Area Office*

**1. Discretionary Fund**

I Gardiner circulated schedules to the member of proposed driver feedback signs locations and the list of schemes for consideration for public lighting. It was noted that a new policy on public lighting is being drafted for the county. I Gardiner advised that €20,000 had already been set aside as part of a discretionary fund under the road works programme for driver feedback signs.

Cllr Dunphy proposed that 15 driver feedback signs be installed and that €39,250 of the Municipal District Discretionary fund be used to fund the signs leaving the remaining 10,750 which is to be held to support any successful town and village renewals scheme for the Municipal District. If no scheme from the Municipal District is successful the remaining money is to be held to support the community and it's distribution to be agreed as a future meeting. Seconded by Cllr Doherty and agreed by all.

It was agreed by all that K Hanley would write to Minister for Health Mr Simon Harris on behalf of the MD of Piltown seeking the immediate provision a 24/7 Cardiac Service in Waterford.
